Parks Department Food Truck Regulations

Food trucks will only be allowed to set up at specified locations including:

- Hillman Park
- Pavese Park
- Robinson Lake Park
- Veterans Park
- Rugby Field
- City Ball Park
- Fred Rose 8th Street Park

Food trucks will only be able to set up with approval from the Parks Department Office. The staff will check available dates and rentals to make sure there are not any conflicts. The Parks Department has the right to reserve blackout dates due to events etc.

Permission to set up must be submitted to the Parks Department Office at least **ONE WEEK BEFORE** the desired date.

A fee of \$35 is required to be paid in the Parks Department Office for a one-time set up permit.

A fee of \$300 is required to be paid in full to the Parks Department Office for a one year permit. The permit is valid June 1st – May 31st of each year regardless of the date you acquire it.

Food trucks must clean up the entire serving area when leaving the park.

Food trucks must follow the Lake County guidelines including proper health permitting and insurance requirements. A copy of these items must be submitted when applying for the permit.

If you fail to comply with any of these requirements, your permit will be revoked and you will be charged a fine of \$2,500 as sited in General Penalty code 10.99.
