

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2022 - 06

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF HOBART, INDIANA TO SUBMIT A PROJECT PROPOSAL FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEARS 2022

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended to date, Lake County, Indiana is authorized to provide financial assistance to units of general local government for undertaking and carrying out Community Development activities; and

WHEREAS, it is provided in such Act that the unit of general local government shall provide a satisfactory assurance prior to submission of its Application, that Lake County Community Economic Development Department will hold Public Hearings and or Public Comment Periods to obtain views of citizens of Community Development needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hobart, Indiana is proposing a project for assistance under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended to date, and proposes to undertake and make available a total project cost of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$114,672.00); and

WHEREAS, the City of Hobart has held one formal public hearing on the proposed program and has made available to the general public, through the mass media and other sources, information concerning the program; and


WHEREAS, the City of Hobart, Indiana has general knowledge of the proposed uses of such funds and is cognizant of the conditions that are imposed in the undertaking and carrying out of Community Development activities and undertaking with Federal financial assistance under Title 1, including those prohibiting discrimination because of race, color, creed, sex or national origin;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Hobart, Indiana:


