RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01

**APPROVING AND RECOMMENDING COUNCIL APPROVAL OF AN INCREASE IN
THE FOG PERMIT FEE TO FROM \$125 TO \$150**

WHEREAS, the current fee for a FOG (fat, oil, & grease) Permit is \$125 for a two year permit term pursuant to Ordinance No. 2021-01 dated February 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City's Clerk-Treasurer has advised that the time used by the Sanitary District staff to do the investigation and review necessary to determine whether or not a Permit application should be approved and the required annual inspections thereafter has increased since that Ordinance was adopted and that, based on those increased times and resulting increased costs, all as set forth in the schedule in Exhibit A attached hereto, a Fog Permit fee of \$150 for a two (2) year permit term is necessary to cover those increased costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners (Board) finds that it is in the best interest of the Sanitary District and the citizens of Hobart to increase the FOG Permit fee to \$150 so that the permittees pay their fair share of the cost of issuing and monitoring their FOG Permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOBART SANITARY AND STORMWATER DISTRICT that it approves an increase in the FOG Permit fee from \$125 to \$150 for a two (2) year permit term and recommends that the City Council approve an Ordinance establishing the \$150 FOG Permit fee for a two (2) year permit term.
