Ordinance Number 2023 - 30

An Ordinance Establishing an Application Fee for Applicants Requesting the Issuance of City Recommendations to the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission for Alcoholic Beverage Permits in the Municipal Riverfront Development Area

WHEREAS, the Common Council ("Council") of the City of Hobart, Indiana ("City") adopted Resolution No. 2011-16 which designated a certain area of the City as a municipal riverfront development project area ("Area") pursuant to Ind. Code 7.1-3-20-16.1(b) and designated the boundaries of the Area; and

WHEREAS, the Council also adopted Resolution No. 2011-17 which established guidelines and principles governing the issuance of recommendations by the City Executive to the Indiana Alcohol and Tobacco Commission ("ATC") for the issuance of three way permits in the Area; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Resolution No. 2017-02 amending portions of Resolution 2011-17, and the Council adopted Resolution 2023-26 further amending portions of Resolution 2011-17; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires through this Ordinance to ordain certain matters related to Resolution 2011-17, as amended, by the creation of a mandatory Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) application fee, for each application, to be known as the Riverfront District Application Fee to be deposited into the existing Redevelopment Commission Special Fund and to comply with the allowable uses of the fund, and that it be added to the City's Fee Schedule and to publish the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart as follows:

SECTION ONE. The Fee Schedule for the City of Hobart, shall include the Riverfront District Application Fee in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

SECTION TWO: The Municipal Code of the City of Hobart ("Code") is hereby amended by **adding** the language to CHAPTER 32: FUNDS AND OTHER FINANCES, § 32.39(A) entitled "REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION SPECIAL FUND" as follows:

§ 32.39 REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION SPECIAL FUND.


(A) There is created a non-reverting fund of the City, to be known as the Redevelopment Commission Special Fund. Money received by the City or Redevelopment Commission from City-imposed fees for (1) vacant building deduction applications pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-14, and (2) **the Riverfront District Alcoholic Beverage Permit Application Fee (in such amount as stated in the City's then current Fee Schedule)**, shall be deposited in the fund, together with such other fees or moneys received by the Commission, or by the City, as the Council may authorize.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 2024.


SECTION FOUR: All other ordinances or portions thereof in effect prior to the effective date and in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


