**A RESOLUTION DECLARING A HOBART FIRE DEPARTMENT TRUCK SURPLUS
AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL THEREOF THROUGH SALE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety ("Board") of the City of Hobart, Indiana ("City") acts as purchasing agency for the City pursuant to I.C. §5-22-4-5 and Hobart Municipal Code §31.004; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been informed by the City of Hobart Fire Department ("Department") that it has surplus personal property, that is a 2011 Ford F-550 Super Duty 4WD Crew Cab (VIN#1FD0W5HT9BEB20035) used for transport of the Department Drone Team, which is no longer suitable for use by the Department due to inability to equip properly for the Drone Team and the high cost of maintenance, and the Department wishes to dispose of the vehicle in a manner permitted by law; and


WHEREAS, the Board and the Department has agreed to dispose of the Surplus property in compliance with the legal requirements and deliver the net proceeds to the Board for purchase of a replacement vehicle able to efficiently meet the needs of the Drone Team; and

WHEREAS, the Department will advertise the sale of the vehicle with Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus, a national fire department equipment supplier and dealer for the sale of used fire apparatus.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY of the CITY OF HOBART, INDIANA that:


- A. The Board now authorizes Hobart Fire Department to proceed with the advertisement and sale of the Hobart Fire Department surplus vehicle, a 2011 Ford F-550 Super Duty 4WD Crew Cab (VIN#1FD0W5HT9BEB20035) through Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus, and authorizes the additional steps necessary to have the specified surplus vehicle sold, including authorization to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the sale of the referenced surplus vehicle.
- B. All proceeds from the sale of the surplus vehicle shall be deposited into the City of Hobart Public Safety Income Tax fund.
