

**HOBART STORM WATER MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT BOARD OF DIRECTORS  
RESOLUTION No. 2016-01**

**A Resolution Reorganizing the Staff of the Storm Water Management Department**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors (“Board”) of the City of Hobart Storm Water Management Department (“Department”) is the governing body of that Department which is responsible for the administration of the storm water management rules and projects within the City of Hobart, as well as public education concerning the management of storm water; and

WHEREAS, the Department has three (3) employees, the MS4 Coordinator, the Storm Water Project Manager, and its Secretary which the Department shares with the Hobart Sanitary District (“District”); and

WHEREAS, the Executive of the City, who also acts as Executive of the Department and District, has requested that the staff of the Department be Reorganized to provide that each of these staff members report to the City Engineer, who is also a member of the Board, which, also serves as the Board of Commissioners of the District. Because the City Engineer is also appointed by the City Executive, the City Engineer would report to the City Executive as to all matters concerning the Department; and

WHEREAS, this new plan of organization should be adopted to assure proper coordination, efficiency and control of the Department’s functioning by the City Executive. Prior to the appointment of the current City Engineer, that role was filled by a contractor, and the Board , at that time, determined that it was not appropriate for Storm Water Department employees to be managed by a contract engineer; and

WHEREAS, the Board, through Resolution, desires to adopt this new plan of organization and to make it effective immediately.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the City of Hobart Storm Water Management Department, that:

1. The MS4 Coordinator, the Storm Water Project Manager and the Secretary of the Storm Water Management Department shall, in all matters, report and be subordinate to the City Engineer, and the City Engineer shall report, as to all matters relating to the Department, to the City Executive.

2. The plan of organization stated in the preceding paragraph shall take effect upon the adoption of this Resolution, and shall remain in effect until further notice.

ALL OF WHICH is adopted as the Resolution of the Board of Directors of the City of Hobart Storm Water Management on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016.
