5                   **A Resolution Updating resolution Number 2011-17 which established Guidelines**  
6                   **and Principles for the Issuance of City Recommendations for Alcoholic Beverage**  
7                   **Permits in the Hobart Municipal Riverfront Development Area by the Indiana**  
8                   **Alcohol and Tobacco Commission**

11                   WHEREAS, the Common Council (“Council”) of the City of Hobart, Indiana (“City”),  
12                   adopted Resolution No. 2011-16 which authorized the creation of a municipal riverfront  
13                   development project area (“Area”) in the City of Hobart pursuant to I.C. §7.1-3-20-16.1 (b) and  
14                   designated the boundaries thereof; and

15                   WHEREAS, the Council also adopted Resolution No. 2011-17 which established  
16                   guidelines and principles governing the issuance of recommendations of the City to the Indiana  
17                   Alcohol and Tobacco Commission (“ATC”) in support of the issuance of alcoholic beverage  
18                   permits in such municipal riverfront development project areas; and

19                   WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2011-17 states, in Section One thereof that: “The Council  
20                   desires that no more than ten (10) three-way alcoholic beverage permits shall be recommended  
21                   for grant by the ATC, from the date of the adoption of this resolution through December 31,  
22                   2015, within the Area without the further action of the Council; “ and

23                   WHEREAS, five (5) recommendations have been issued for permits under Resolution  
24                   No. 2011-17, but three of these, for 3 Monkeys Pub, Montego Bay and Villa del Sol were issued  
25                   subsequent to December 31, 2015; and

26                   WHEREAS, the Council desires through this Resolution to amend Resolution No. 2011-  
27                   17 by extending the date by which additional recommendations may be made without further  
28                   action of the Council, and to approve the above referenced three recommendations that were  
29                   made after the date prescribed in said Resolution.




THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart as follows:

*SECTION ONE:* Resolution 2011-17 is amended by striking out in its entirety the last sentence in Section One and inserting in lieu thereof the following new sentence: “The Council desires that no more than ten (10) new three-way alcoholic beverage permits, not including those already issued and those approved in the succeeding paragraph of this Resolution, shall be recommended for grant by the ATC, from the date of the adoption of this resolution through December 31, 2022.” All other provisions of Resolution 2011-17 are hereby affirmed.



ALL OF WHICH is adopted as the Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Indiana on this First day of March, 2017.


