

RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 12

A Resolution to Define the Hobart Nature District

WHEREAS, the Common Council ("Council") of the City of Hobart, Indiana ("City") previously adopted Resolution 2013-08 on April 17, 2013 which, approved and adopted the Hobart Marsh Plan as an amendment to the Hobart Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, it was identified in the Hobart Marsh Plan in 2013 that there is a need to implement gateways and signage as entrance ways into the Marsh area.; and

WHEREAS, the Legacy Foundation awarded the City of Hobart, the Hobart YMCA and other parties a Spotlight Grant to use to study ways to improve the quality of life in the northwest corner of Hobart; and

WHEREAS, the Spotlight Grant resulted in the production of a report summarizing ideas to promote the northwest corner of Hobart; and

WHEREAS, the Spotlight Grant summary report recommended that the areas in the northwest corner of Hobart that are part of the Hobart Marsh Plan should be promoted as a way of improving the overall quality of life in the northwest corner of Hobart; and


WHEREAS, it was determined that the phrase 'Hobart Nature District' is the best way to refer to the areas that are part of the Hobart Marsh Plan.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Indiana as follows:

SECTION ONE: The land included as part of the Hobart Marsh Plan shall be known as the 'Hobart Nature District' on signs and other labels and the 'Hobart Nature District' shall refer to the area of the City of Hobart that is part of the Hobart Marsh Plan.



ALL OF WHICH is ADOPTED as the resolution of the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Indiana on this 19th day of July, 2017.









