

46 SECTION 2. Title – Citation – Reference. This Code shall be known as
47 the “City of Hobart Municipal Code” and it shall be sufficient to cite to or refer to
48 said Code as such in any prosecution for the violation of any provision thereof or
49 in any proceeding at law or equity. It shall be sufficient to designate any
50 ordinance adding to, amending, correcting or repealing all or any part or portion
51 thereof as an addition to, amendment to, correction or repeal of the “City of
52 Hobart Municipal Code.” Further reference may be had to the titles, chapters,
53 sections and subsections of the “City of Hobart Municipal Code” and such
54 references shall apply to that numbered title, chapter, section or subsection as it
55 appears in the code. The Code may be referenced , as to each section as follows:
56 “HMC § _____.” This Code is declared to be prima facie evidence of the law
57 of the City of Hobart, Indiana and shall be received in evidence as such by the
58 courts of the State of Indiana.

59
60 SECTION 3. Codification Authority. The Code consists of all of the
61 ordinances of general and permanent application, including regulatory and penal
62 ordinances of the City of Hobart, Indiana, codified by subject matter pursuant to
63 the provisions of the Indiana Code cited above. The Code adopted and enacted
64 herein is a restatement of properly enacted ordinances of the City of Hobart and
65 such ordinances shall be considered to have been re-ordained by passage of the
66 Code as provided in I.C. §36-1-5-6 through this Ordinance. The Code adopted
67 herein also adopts by reference certain statutes and administrative rules of the
68 State of Indiana as identified in the Code.

70 SECTION 4. Ordinances Passed Prior to Adoption of the Code. The Code
71 adopted herein is current through June 30, 2017 and Ordinance No. 2017-10.

73 SECTION 5. Reference Applies to All Amendments. Whenever reference
74 is made to this code as the “City of Hobart Municipal Code” or to any portion
75 thereof, or to any ordinance of the City of Hobart, Indiana, the reference shall
76 apply to all amendments, corrections and additions heretofore, now or hereafter
77 made.

79 SECTION 6. Title, Chapter and Section Headings. Title, chapter and
80 section headings contained in this Code shall not be deemed to govern, limit,
81 modify or in any manner affect the scope, meaning or intent of the provisions of
82 any title, chapter or section thereof.

83
84 SECTION 7. Reference to Specific Ordinances. The provisions of this
85 Code shall not in any manner affect matters of record which refer to, or are
86 otherwise connected with ordinances which are therein specifically designated by
87 number or otherwise and which are included within the code, but such reference
88 shall be construed to apply to the corresponding provisions contained within this
89 Code.

91 SECTION 8. Effect of Code on Past Actions and Obligations. Neither the
92 adoption of this Code nor the repeal or amendment hereby of any ordinance or
93 part or portion of any ordinance of the City shall in any manner affect the
94 prosecution for violations of ordinances, which violations were committed prior
95 to the effective date hereof, nor affect any right established prior to the effective
96 date hereof, nor be construed as a waiver of any license, fee, charge or penalty at
97 said effective date due and unpaid under such ordinances, nor be construed as
98 affecting any of the provisions of such ordinances relating to the collection of any
99 such license, fee, charge or penalty, or the penal provisions applicable to any
100 violation thereof, nor to affect the validity of any bond or cash deposit in lieu
101 thereof required to be posted, filed or deposited pursuant to any ordinance and all
102 rights and obligations pertaining thereto shall continue in full force and effect.



104 SECTION 9. Effective Date. This code shall become effective
105 immediately upon the adoption of this Ordinance in the manner required by law.


107 SECTION 10. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or
108 phrase of this Code is for any reason held to be invalid, unenforceable or
109 unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining
110 portions of this Code. The Common Council hereby declares that it would have
111 passed this code, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase
112 thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more of these parts had been
113 declared invalid or unconstitutional, and if for any reason this Code should be
114 declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original ordinance or ordinances
115 shall be in full force and effect.

117 SECTION 11. Subsequent Enactments and Amendments. The Clerk-
118 Treasurer, in consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to issue
119 periodic amendments to the Code as new ordinances of permanent and general
120 application in the City are enacted, and to issue new pages or portions thereof for
121 the purpose of keeping the Code current. Amendments to the code made in accord
122 with this section shall be presumed to be as effective as the underlying ordinance
123 which is the subject of an amendment, for all purposes.






