

ORDINANCE 2018-11

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE 2018 BUDGET OF THE GENERAL FUND, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND CLERK-TREASURER'S DEPARTMENT IN THE CITY OF HOBART, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, it has been determined it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget in certain line items in the General Fund, Economic Development Department in the 2018 budget; and
