**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE
UNITED STEELWORKERS OF AMERICA**


- WHEREAS**, on March 7, 1937, the Steelworkers Union signed the first contract, with Carnege-Illinois Steel, for \$5.00 a day wage benefits; and
- WHEREAS**, on May 2, 1942, the United Steelworkers of America was officially created to negotiate for steelworkers; and
- WHEREAS**, the three year labor agreement for 30,000 steelworkers in the United States was set to expire on September 1, 2018; and
- WHEREAS**, encouraged by its most recent discussions with ArcelorMittal and U.S. Steel at the bargaining table, the United Steelworkers did not call for a strike on September 1, 2018 and continue to negotiate in good faith; and
- WHEREAS**, ArcelorMittal, the world's largest steelmaker and U.S. Steel, the largest steel company in Lake County, are expected to negotiate with the Steelworkers Union in good faith; and
- WHEREAS**, the City of Hobart Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer and Common Council support the United Steelworkers of America in their fight for equity and fair treatment of current and retired steelworkers.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of Hobart Mayor, Clerk-Treasurer and Common Council, representing the citizens and voters of Hobart, Indiana, supports the United Steelworkers of America Union and encourages ArcelorMittal and U.S. Steel to reach a fair agreement with the Union.

That a copy of this Resolution be published in the record of the City of Hobart.


