3                   **ORDINANCE NO. 2013-15**

5                   **An Ordinance Approving Street Parking and Other Restrictions**  
6                   **on a Certain Portion of Lillian Street at and near its Intersection with Ohio Street**  
7                   **in the City of Hobart**

10                  WHEREAS, the Common Council (“Council”) of the City of Hobart, Indiana (“City”)  
11                  has received requests for the establishment of certain parking and related street restrictions on  
12                  Lillian Street, at and near the intersection with Ohio Street in the City; and

13                  WHEREAS, the City Planning and Engineering Departments in consultation with the  
14                  Chief of Police has determined that the current unrestricted parking on both sides of Lillian  
15                  Street near the intersection impedes the ability of school buses and similar vehicles to negotiate  
16                  the intersection safely; and

17                  WHEREAS, as a matter of public safety, the Chief and said Departments have requested  
18                  that parking be prohibited on the South Side of Lillian Street from Ohio Street Eastward to the  
19                  School City Service Center Drive, and

20                  WHEREAS, the Chief and said Departments have also requested that the Oak-Savannah  
21                  Bicycle Trail be delineated upon the South side of Lillian Street between the Trail’s connection  
22                  with Lillian Street and the end of Lillian Street to the East, and that a pedestrian sidewalk be  
23                  located on the North side of Lillian Street for Trail using pedestrians from the connection of the  
24                  Trail with Lillian Street on the West to its connection with the Trail at the Eastern end of Lillian  
25                  Street; and

26                  WHEREAS, pursuant to §72.06 of the Municipal Code of the City of Hobart, the Chief of  
27                  police is authorized to designate, with the approval of the Common Council, streets, alleys, parts  
28                  of streets or alleys, and all city-owned property, including parking areas where parking shall be

1 prohibited at all times, or at certain times, or shall be restricted to certain vehicles; and

2 WHEREAS, the Council desires to approve the requested parking and other restrictions  
3 requested by the Planning, Engineering and Police departments as described above and to make  
4 them effective as soon as practicable;

5 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of  
6  
7 Hobart, Indiana as follows:

8  
9 SECTION ONE. The following designated parking limitations and restrictions of  
10 are hereby approved, to wit:

11  
12 A. All parking is prohibited at all times on the South Side of  
13 Lillian Street from Ohio Street Eastward to the School City Service Center  
14 Drive;



16 B. The Oak-Savannah Bicycle Trail is hereby established  
17 upon the South side of Lillian Street between the Trail's connection with  
18 Lillian Street on the West and the end of Lillian Street to the East, and that  
19 a pedestrian sidewalk is hereby established and located on the North side  
20 of Lillian Street for Trail-using pedestrians from the connection of the  
21 Trail with Lillian Street on the West to its connection with the Trail at the  
22 Eastern end of Lillian Street.

23  
24 SECTION TWO: The City Department of Public Works shall erect "No Parking"  
25 or "No Parking This Side of Street" signs or signs with some other suitable warning  
26 required to carry out the restrictions imposed by the previous section. The Department of  
27 Public Works shall also mark pavements and curbs in the manner required to give notice  
28 and warning of the restrictions imposed by the previous section, all of which shall  
29 conform to the current edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices  
30 adopted and made effective for use in the State of Indiana. When such signs are so  
31 erected, subject to Section Three of this ordinance, the parking restrictions of Section  
32 One of this ordinance shall take effect.

33  
34 SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption in  
35 the manner required by law, and upon publication thereof pursuant to I.C. §36-3-4-6-  
36 14(b) in two newspapers of general circulation published within the City pursuant to I.C.  
37 §5-3-1-4 (a).




