**A Resolution to Accept Ownership and Maintenance
of the Street Lights on Norris Drive**

WHEREAS, the City of Hobart previously accepted conveyance of the street, sewer and related infrastructure to the Deep River Pointe development which consists of all homes located on Norris Drive in the City; and


WHEREAS, the street lights on Norris Drive were inadvertently excluded by said conveyance and acceptance and the Deep River Pointe Property Owners Association, Inc. has requested the Board to accept ownership and maintenance of said lights as evidenced by the Association's letter attached to and made a part of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the administration has advised that there is no reason why such street lights should not be accepted by the City.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Hobart, Indiana, that:

The Board now accepts the ownership and maintenance responsibility for all of the existing streetlights and any future street lights located on Norris Drive, and the right to re-configure, replace, connect and disconnect street lights as it deems necessary and desirable..
