A Resolution Requesting Hearing Before the Hobart Fire Pension Board in the Matter of Private Nick Sneiderwine

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety ("Board"), of the City of Hobart, Indiana ("City"), has received a request from Randal Smith, Fire Chief, to ask the Hobart Fire Pension Board ("Pension Board") to conduct a hearing to determine whether Private Nick Sneiderwine of the Fire Department has an impairment or disability which prevents him from performing an essential function of his position as authorized by I.C. §36-8-8-12.3 (a); and


WHEREAS, there appears to be good cause to support the Chief's request, and this Board notes that Private Sneiderwine disputes the contention that he is impaired or disabled; and

WHEREAS, the Pension Board has sole authority to determine this issue under the above-cited statute and this Board desires to resolve this issue through fair proceedings conducted before the Pension Board in the manner required by law.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Hobart, Indiana, that:

The Board requests the Hobart Fire Pension Board to conduct the hearing requested above to determine whether Private Nick Sneiderwine of the Fire Department has an impairment or disability which prevents him from performing an essential function of his position as authorized by I.C. §36-8-8-12.3 (a). This Board requests, further, that the Clerk-Treasurer serve this request upon the Secretary of the Pension Board, forthwith.
