Resolution No. 2020-01

A Resolution Authorizing the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Hobart to Award Contract for Tree-Clearing Services for the 69th Avenue Improvement Project

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Commission of the City of Hobart (“RDC”) has received notice of award of a significant grant from the Northwest Indiana Regional Development Authority (“Authority”) for a project to reconstruct and improve 69th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said grant, the RDC has approved the issuance of lease-rental bonds for the remainder of the funds necessary to finance the completion of the reconstruction of 69th Avenue from Mississippi Street East to Colorado Street, including construction of a roundabout intersection at Colorado Street and 69th Avenue, such project to be awarded by the RDC in March, 2020, pursuant to sealed bid in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, the RDC desires to prepare for the project by authorizing the issuance of a Solicitation for Quotes for tree-clearing services in the anticipated right-of-way for the project so that the contractor later chosen by bid will not be delayed in commencing work; and


WHEREAS, the RDC does not meet again after its January 20, 2020 meeting until February 21, 2020 and will not award the contract for the 69th Avenue Project until March 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS, quotes for the tree-clearing contract will be received on January 31, 2020, and it is necessary and desirable for the RDC to authorize the Hobart Board of Public Works and Safety (“Board”) to award the tree-clearing contract at the Board’s regular meeting of February 5, 2020 so that the work under that contract may begin without delay.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the Hobart Redevelopment Commission that:

1. The Board is hereby authorized and requested to review said quotes at its meeting of February 5, 2020 for Tree-Clearing Services and to award the contract for same to the lowest responsible and responsive quoter, subject to the RDC’s later approval and execution of the contract at its meeting of February 21, 2020.
2. The RDC will administer and manage said contract after its award, including the issuance of Notice to Proceed, the approval of contract documents, payment requests and change orders, the receipt of construction progress reports, and all other functions in connection with the tree-clearing contract.
