

ORDINANCE 2021 - 21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2020-14 OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOBART, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, TO ESTABLISH A NEW POSITION IN THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT AND FIXING THE SALARIES FOR SUCH POSITION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Lake County, Indiana adopted Ordinance 2020-14 fixing the salaries of officers and employees of the City of Hobart for Fiscal Year 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council with the recommendation of the Hobart Sanitary District also adopted Ordinance 2021-01: *Establishing Rules for the Use of the City's Sanitary Sewer System and the Pretreatment Program for Users that Discharge Non-Domestic Wastes to its Sanitary Sewer System and Excess Strength Surcharges* on February 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as part of Ordinance 2021-01, a FOG (Fats, Oils & Grease) Permit and fee was established which includes annual site inspections that will be scheduled and completed by an employee of the Building Department, designated and trained as a Fog Permit Inspector as part of the permitting process in cooperation with the Hobart Sanitary District to be paid per inspection from FOG permit fees; and

WHEREAS, the Building Department is now ready to begin issuing FOG permits and scheduling inspections as required for same; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council now desires to amend Ordinance 2020-14 to create the new position of a FOG Permit Inspector and set the per inspection rate as recommended by the Hobart Sanitary District and the Building Official;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart, Lake County, Indiana as follows:


SECTION ONE: That Ordinance 2020-14 be amended to add the following position, line item and rate of pay in the Building Department budget:



SECTION THREE: All other provisions of Ordinance 2020-14 shall remain in full force and effect.






