4                   **An Ordinance Amending the Municipal Code of the City of Hobart Concerning**  
5                   **Large Trucks, Trailers or Other Vehicles with a Gross Weight in Excess of 11,000**  
6                   **Pounds Parking On or Near Districts Zoned Residential**

8                   WHEREAS, the Common Council (“Council”) of the City of Hobart, Indiana (“City”) has been informed that large trucks, trailers or vehicles in excess of 11,000 pounds are utilizing parking near residentially zoned districts causing a nuisance for local residents residing within the City; and

13                   WHEREAS, the Council has determined that there is a need to establish and enforce that the parking of such vehicles shall be prohibited within a 200-foot radius of residentially zoned areas, subject to certain exceptions, within the City; and

17                   WHEREAS, the Council, through this Ordinance, desires to enact such an ordinance to prohibit the parking of such vehicles near residential districts;

20                   THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Hobart as follows:

23                                   *SECTION ONE:* The Municipal Code of the City of Hobart (“Code”) is hereby amended by inserting the following new language to CHAPTER 72: PARKING RULES, § 72:02 entitled “TRUCKS; PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS; EXCEPTION” as follows:

28                   **§ 72.02 TRUCKS; PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS; EXCEPTION.**

30                   (A) It is unlawful to park any truck, trailer or vehicle designed or operated for the transportation of property that has a gross vehicle weight in excess of **11,000 pounds on, or within 200 feet of, any residential dwelling within the City**; provided that, any such truck, trailer or vehicle may stop or park in such places solely for the purpose of delivery, loading or unloading material **or it is parked on the property of its primary place of business. If the truck, trailer or vehicle is not parked at its primary place of business**, such parking shall be permitted only for that length of time reasonably necessary to accomplish the delivery, loading or unloading.
